HISTORICAL REFERENCE

The Apennine Peninsula is the place where the maximum number of UNESCO monuments is concentrated. Today there are 55 of them. Rome, Venice, Genoa, the Dolomites are all open-air museums. However, among all the regions of Italy, the most cultural monuments are concentrated in Sicily. In Sicily, we have the largest number of protected areas.

It was here that the first cities were founded and the first culture arose, long before the foundation of Rome, in the 14th century BC. The cultural monuments of Sicily protected by UNESCO include Cathedral in Cefalu; cultural sites of the Sicilian capital Palermo: Cathedral, Norman Palace, Chapel Palatina, Zamiralo Bridge, Ziza Palace, Church of St. John Eremiti, Church of St. Cataldo, Church of St. Mary Ammirallo, Duomo Monreale; temples of Agrigento; ancient Gothic in Syracuse; Mount Etna; 8 cities in the southeastern part of the island (the provinces of Catania, Syracuse, Ragusa), so-called the Cities of the Sicilian Baroque: Catania, Noto, Modica, Ragusa, Scicli, Palazzolo, Militello val di Catania, Caltagirone.

We will visit the provinces, where the cities of the Sicilian Baroque are located, the provinces of Catania, Siracusa and Ragusa.
